DRESS CODE

The PGA National Members' Club House Committee and the Board of Governors have approved the following dress code:

- Blue jeans, blue jean skirts, blue jean shorts or blue jean dresses are not permitted.
- Excessively short shorts, dresses or skirts are not permitted.
- No exercise attire permitted (sweat pants/suits).
- Cutoffs; ripped or torn parts on clothing are not permitted.
- Midsections must be covered.
- Tee shirts, shirts/sweat shirts with graphics are not permitted.
- Tank tops for men are not permitted.
- Caps/visors are not permitted indoors for men.
- Excessively tight, short or baggy clothing is considered inappropriate.
- Jackets for gentlemen are optional with exception of some special events.
- Collared shirts or banded collared dress shirts are required for gentlemen.
- Appropriate blouses/tops are required for ladies. Bermuda shorts & tennis attire are permitted.



Why Do We Have a Dress Code? The House Committee of PGA National Members' Club has adopted a dress code to preserve the Club's ambience as a respectable, family-oriented destination for intimate dinners, business functions, and family gatherings.

Appropriate Attire

The Committee wants all Members to feel comfortable and proud of the Club as a first-class destination. You are responsible for your family & guests' attire.

Cell Phones MUST be placed on silent or vibrate. NO cell phone conversations are permitted in dining/bar areas.

Please Remember: In all areas, for all ages, and for both genders, excessively tight, short or baggy clothing is NOT considered appropriate attire. Please always err on the conservative side when contemplating what to wear at the Club.

Please remember to inform all guests and children of this dress code BEFORE coming to the Club.

- Exercise attire
