We thank you in advance for your cooperation throughout the event, and hope that you too will enjoy the PGA TOUR's best battle on your Champion Course, while supporting local children's charities.

MEMBER CLUBHOUSE

- Club Access:
 - ♣ The Members Clubhouse will be reserved for the exclusive use of the PGA TOUR Professionals until 6:00pm daily Monday, March 1 – Sunday, March 7, 2010 during the tournament. The Members' Club invites you to have lunch along the 9th green at the Members' Only Tent. A member grill including burgers, hot dogs, and chicken with assorted salads and accompaniments, a full service bar and seating will be available 11:00am-4:00pm daily. Your membership card and Honda ticket will be required to gain access to the Members' Tent. Members may bring up to 4 accompanied guests each day.
 - ♣ Members are invited to purchase tickets to the Members' Hospitality Patio which is situated along the 18th fairway, Wednesday-Sunday from 9:00am-5:00pm. Pricing as follows: \$20- Wednesday (dry snacks and sodas only), \$50- Thursday, \$60- Friday, \$70- Saturday or Sunday, per person, per day. Thursday, Friday, Saturday & Sunday includes continental breakfast, lunch, afternoon snacks, beer, wine, sodas and the best view available. Tickets may be purchased for all five days for \$235 per person. Premium cocktails may be purchased for \$5 each.
 - ♣ Evening Dining at the Club-

 - Thursday:* "Tour Buffet" with selections of PGA TOUR Professionals' favorites from 6:00-8:00pm

 - ♣ After 6:00pm, entry for Club dining will be from the front entrance of the Resort. (Complimentary valet).
 - ♣ All articles must be removed from **ALL Men's Lockers by Friday, February 26th** at 5:00pm. Ladies are asked to remove any needed items from their lockers as there will be no access to the ladies' lockers after Sunday, February 28th.

Honda Tickets for Members:

Free of Charge: One (1) weekly book of grounds tickets for **Tuesday, March 2** through **Sunday, March 7, 2010** at no charge. Valued at \$95. (Offer limited to one complimentary book per membership).

50% Discount: Up to three (3) additional weekly books of grounds tickets for \$47.50 each. (Members may purchase no more than three books at the discounted rate. Additional books may be purchased for \$95 each.) Tickets must be paid by check or cash payable to Children's Healthcare Charity and picked up at the Membership Services office prior to the tournament. Tickets may be picked up at the Members' Club Monday-Friday, 8:30am-4:30pm and Saturdays 9:00-1:00pm until Saturday, February 27th. Tickets may be picked up during the tournament in the Human Resources Office next to the golf pro shop.

GOLF ACCESS & TEE TIMES

- **Play:** The Squire, Haig, Palmer and Estate Course will be open throughout the tournament for Members with advance tee time reservations.
- **Practice:** Members wishing to practice full swing, short game shots and putting are asked to please use the Estate Course from Monday, March 1 – Monday, March 8, 2010.
- The Champion Course closes for play at 9:30am on Friday, February 26 and reopens on Tuesday, March 9, 2010.
- **Remote Staging** will begin February 18th.

- **Parking Pass:** Members with starting times on the Haig, Squire or Palmer will need to pick-up a Valet Parking Pass. Members may pick the pass up one day prior or on the day of play.
 - ♣ There will be one Valet Parking Pass issued per foursome.
 - ♣ Parking Passes will be available for pick-up at “Will Call” beginning Sunday, February 28th - Sunday, March 7, 2010 at the Jog Road Fire Station located ¼ mile north of the PGA National entrance on Jog Road. Hours: 7:00am–5:00pm. Golfers will be directed to the Members’ valet area as a drop off point prior to play. The Members’ valet may be accessed after passing the checkpoint by proceeding to the stop sign in front of the Resort entrance and taking a right, then an immediate right into the parking lot.
 - ♣ **A \$100 fee will be charged to any member who picks up a parking pass and subsequently does not play golf on the assigned day. To avoid the penalty, passes must be returned to Will Call no later than 9:00 am the day of play. Members will be given a receipt for their returned pass.**
 - ♣ The Members’ Valet Circle in front of the Clubhouse will be closed.
 - ♣ The number of passes issued each day will be limited to the number of available starting times on each of the courses
 - ♣ No Valet Parking Pass is required for any activity at the Estates Golf Course.

PARKING: TUESDAY, MARCH 2 – SUNDAY, MARCH 7, 2010

- **General Information:** Parking at PGA National Resort & Club will be restricted beginning Monday, March 1, 2010. Valid Parking Passes must be displayed in vehicle’s front windshield.
 - ♣ Any vehicles on property from 6:00am–6:00pm without a valid dated Parking Pass may be towed at the owner’s expense.
 - ♣ Only cars with a Valid Parking Pass AND Member’s name on a current reservation list at the main checkpoint will be allowed on Resort property.
 - ♣ Security will maintain a list of all reservations at the main checkpoint.
 - ♣ Date stamped Valid Parking Passes can be obtained from the “Will Call” location at the Jog Road Fire Station located ¼ mile north of the PGA National entrance on Jog Road.
- **Golf Courses:** Please refer to information above
- **Spa Access:** Members will be able to obtain a valet parking pass if they have an advance reservation in the Spa or Salon. Same-day appointments will not be taken during this period; all appointments will need to be booked no later than 4:00pm the evening prior.
 - ♣ Valet will be available at the spa entrance for Members with confirmed appointments.
 - ♣ Parking Passes will be limited to number of available Spa/Salon appointments each day.
- **Health and Racquet Access:** Parking passes will be issued for Members utilizing the Health and Racquet Club and Croquet at the parking check point on the day of usage beginning Monday, March 1st. Membership cards must be presented at the parking check point and parking passes must be displayed in the car window. Parking will be located in the Health and Racquet Club parking lot. Parking passes are valid for a 2 hour maximum on the date of issue.
- **Spectator Member Parking:** Spectator Member parking will be located in the Preferred Parking Area this year, which will be located at Mirasol Park off Jog Road, north of PGA Blvd. Members will be required to show their Member card for complimentary parking.

SHUTTLE SERVICE

- The Honda Classic will be providing complimentary shuttle bus exclusively for residents of PGA National. A continuous shuttle loop will operate 9:00am to 6:00pm Thursday, March 4th – Sunday, March 7th. Residents can access the shuttle at one of the four neighborhood Shuttle Stop locations below:
 1. Avenue of the Master at the Bristol Club (across from Masters Park)
 2. Avenue of the Masters at General Drive
 3. Tournament Boulevard at Medalist Avenue
 4. Ryder Cup Boulevard at Glencairn Road
 5. Resort Entrance

Complimentary resident shuttle drop off and pick up will be located at the bottom of the hill (North side) in front of resort valet. Location will be identified by “Resident Shuttle” signage.

TOURNAMENT ACCESS

- The main Tournament entrance is located between the Champion Practice Range and Squire #18 green. Residents may gain access by walking to the Champion #15 Tee Gate entrance off Ryder Cup Boulevard. Tickets will be sold at this gate.
